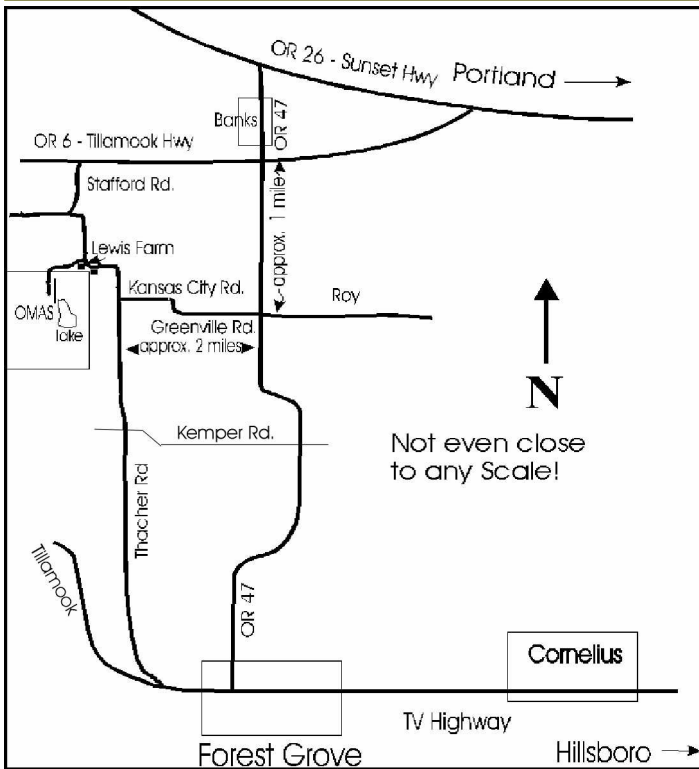

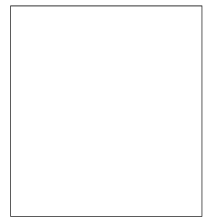
Next Regular Meeting
